Decision Statement published pursuant to the Localism Act 2011 Schedule 38A (9) and Regulation 19 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012

Cheshire West and Chester Council on 15 March 2017 decided to make the Kelsall and Willington Neighbourhood Plan under Section 38A(4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. The Kelsall and Willington Neighbourhood Plan now forms part of the Development Plan for the Kelsall, Upper Kelsall and Willington Corner Neighbourhood Area.
