

Notice of Publication of the Tarvin Neighbourhood Plan

The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 and Localism Act 2011
Regulation 16

A neighbourhood plan has been prepared for the Tarvin neighbourhood area which aims to give local people a greater say about future development in the area. The plan sets out a number of key objectives and policies to be used when determining planning applications.

The plan has now been submitted to Cheshire West and Chester Council and a period of publicity will take place between Monday 28 January and 5pm on Monday 11 March 2019. During this time, any interested parties can make comments on the plan and accompanying documents. Following the publicity period, an independent Examiner will be appointed who will consider the plan and any comments made.
