Whitegate and Marton Neighbourhood Plan

Decision Statement published pursuant to the Localism Act 2011 Schedule 38A (9) and Regulation 19 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012

Cheshire West and Chester Council on 3 May 2017 decided to make the Whitegate and Marton Neighbourhood Plan under Section 38A(4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. The Whitegate and Marton Neighbourhood Plan now forms part of the Development Plan for the Whitegate and Marton Neighbourhood Area.

Decision and reasons

The minute of the decision and reasons for it reads as follows:

DECIDED: That

the making of the Whitegate and Marton Neighbourhood Plan be confirmed with the consequence that it becomes part of the development plan for the Neighbourhood Area.
