

Notice of Publication of the Winsford Neighbourhood Development Plan Proposal

**The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 and Localism Act 2011.
Regulation 16**

The proposal

Winsford Town Council has prepared a neighbourhood development plan for Winsford. The plan aims to give local people a greater say about what happens in their area and provides a vision for the future of the town. It sets out a number of key objectives for the area and planning policies which it wishes to be used to help determine planning applications in the Winsford area.

All submitted comments will be collated and will be made publicly available after 16th September 2013.

The publicity period runs from Monday 15th July until Monday 16th September 2013. As such, any comments should be received by the Council by 5pm on Monday 16th September 2013. Comments received after this time may not be considered.
